Traditional clinical beds and gurneys can feel institutional and may not support a calm, therapeutic environment. The Zeller Sleeper	Chair provides an adjustable alternative, allowing patients to move between chair position and flat position while remaining in their own personal space. Designed for EmPATH units and wider behavioural health settings, the chair supports comfort, dignity and flexibility throughout assessment, treatment and recovery.

✓ **DESIGNED IN ASSOCIATION WITH DR. SCOTT ZELLER**

The Zeller Sleeper Chair was designed in association with Dr. Scott Zeller, an emergency psychiatrist with almost 40 years’ experience in behavioural healthcare and a leading advocate of EmPATH units: Emergency Psychiatric Assessment, Treatment and Healing programmes.

Through his work developing EmPATH units around the world, Dr. Zeller identified the importance of creating calm, therapeutic environments where patients feel safe, comfortable and supported.

His philosophy that “*the environment is a treatment in itself*” helped shape the Zeller Sleeper Chair’s design, resulting in an inviting, adjustable seating solution that supports therapy, relaxation and rest within emergency behavioural health and crisis care settings.

✓ **SUPPORTS A CALMING ENVIRONMENT**

The Zeller Sleeper Chair adapts to different stages of a patient’s stay, providing a comfortable place to sit, engage and rest. In chair position, users can comfortably take part in conversations, assessments, group sessions or everyday activities, before moving into the flat position when they need time to relax or sleep.

This flexibility helps reduce the need to move patients between different types of furniture, supporting a more consistent and comfortable experience throughout assessment, treatment and recovery.
