MATERIAL/FABRICATION

During periods of stress or anxiety, some of us may find ourselves engaging in repetitive movements like fingerdrumming or leg-bouncing as a form of release. But for those living on the autism spectrum, repetitive movements are often part of everyday life. Rocking back and forth can help to minimise the impact of outside stimuli, providing a source of focus, and in turn, a feeling of calm. Interior made from CMHR (combustion modified high resilience) foam to ensure maximum support, durability and comfort.

The curved plywood ski is finished in matt lacquer with white pigment. Security screws are recessed into the plywood so they do not damage the floor surface.
